On arrival at Heriot-Watt University please park in the main visitors car park situated to the right of the main avenue into the campus. Please book into your accommodation at main reception in the

James Watt Centre. Your key will be available for collection from 14.00 hours onwards on the day of arrival. James Watt Centre reception is open 24hrs.

Please note that dinner is only available until 20.00 during the vacation and 19.00 during term time.

Guests are asked to vacate their room and return their key to reception by 10.00am on the morning of departure. Luggage may be left temporarily in the baggage room at James Watt Centre Reception.

Payments can be made by cash, cheque, switch, solo, delta or credit card.

All rooms are supplied with towels and bed linen.

Extra blankets and pillows are available, please ask at the James Watt Centre Reception. Requests for extra items must be made between 08.00 and 12.00 or by prior arrangement.

All rooms have telephones. Please see the accompanying information in your bedroom pack. Please note that travel plugs are **not** provided in your accommodation.

These rooms have telephone, en-suite toilet and shower and tea and coffee making facilities. Guests have use of a TV lounge, which can be accessed by using your room key.

These bedrooms in Leonard Horner Hall have en-suite toilet and shower, tea/coffee facilities, hairdryer and telephone.

Irons and ironing boards are provided in your accommodation, please contact James Watt Centre Reception on Ext 3501 to be advised of their location within your residence.

Launderette facilities are also available on campus, please contact James Watt Centre Reception for details The machines are coin operated, a wash costs £2.00 and the dryers cost £1.00 per complete dry cycle (45 Minutes).

The Card point plc machine only accepts UK cards on the LINK network and charges £1.50 per transaction.

Sports Centre

The centre has a multi-gym and cardio - vascular suite, as well as squash, tennis and badminton courts, a jogging circuit, a general all weather pitch and outdoor rugby and football pitches.
