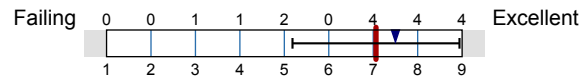

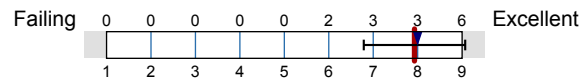

How would you rate your instructor as an effective teacher?



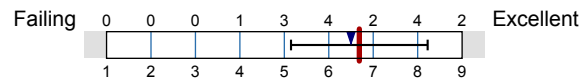

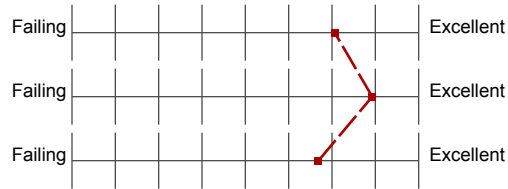

- I thought the professor did a very good job explaining the complex concepts of this course and I greatly appreciated how he would post an outline of exam topics, as well as practice exams to help us prepare for our midterm/final.
- Kozhan is a very effective teacher, as he clarifies hard concepts in simpler terms. I like his teaching style a lot.
- The course itself is difficult enough as it is, but I found it even more complicated because I felt like I had to learn everything on my own. The professor was nice and tried, but his teaching style isn't really helpful. I didn't feel like I knew what was going on because he would just speed through the proofs of the theorems. I don't know if the exams are difficult, but considering such a lower average--it meant nobody knew anything. I didn't get much out of this class.
- The material is rushed, the textbook is wordy, and the professor didn't seem to care.
- The teacher literally teaches out of the book. He doesn't spend a lot of time expanding on proofs. He does post what material will be on exams which is nice. His grading seems a bit harsh considering his averages on exams were in the 20s or 30s. Told students that we'd be sure to do bad on a section.
