

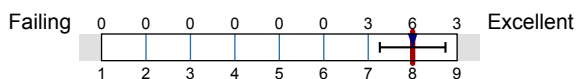

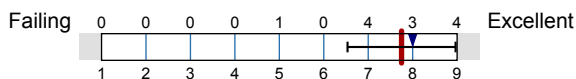

How would you rate your instructor as an effective teacher?



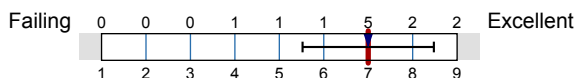

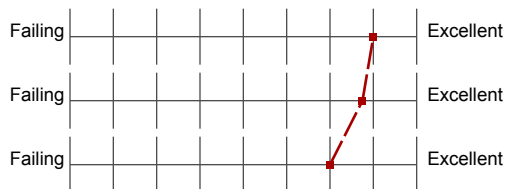

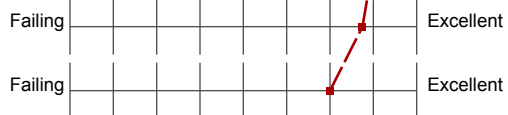

I think the examinations were on the too-long/too-difficult side, but he did warn us on the first day of class that they tended to be difficult. He was very helpful, not condescending, patient, and available for office hours often.

Overall, he's probably the best math instructor I've had so far.
